- Recently, not only young people but also elderly people have begun to use social media. As the population of the Kenjinkai continues to age, the Kenjinkai need to use these new tools to keep people informed of the Kenjinkai's presence.
- The Exchange Student Scholarships Program for Descendants of Immigrants and the Short Term Visit Program for Descendants of Immigrants play a very important role in nurturing the next generation of the Kenjinkai, and since those are part of the Kenjinkai's programs, some people have even become Kenjinkai members.
- As for the Youth Mission Program, the Kenjinkai have been working together to strengthen unity among the associations.
- In order to revitalize the Kenjinkai, it is extremely important to develop children and the younger generation in particular and make them interact among them, so these programs need to be continued.
- We seek to increase the number of members by distributing PR magazines in various languages at local events to promote Fukuoka Prefecture.
- By sending out people familiar with the traditional culture of Fukuoka Prefecture to the Kenjinkai, by hosting homestays for young people in the prefecture, and by mutual exchanges of elementary and junior high school teachers, we hope to increase the number of people in each country with interest in the Kenjinkai, which will result in strengthening the foundation of the Kenjinkai.
- We aim to mutually develop both the prefecture and the Kenjinkai by actively carrying out these interpersonal exchanges between the prefecture and the Kenjinkai.

Overseas, there are 39 Kenjinkai associations in 24 countries and regions, including the North and South American Kenjinkai formed by emigrants from Fukuoka Prefecture and the Asian and European Kenjinkai formed by corporate expats.

Overseas emigration from Fukuoka Prefecture began in 1885 with emigration to Hawaii. In Japan, Fukuoka Prefecture had the fourth-largest number of emigrants after Hiroshima, Okinawa, and Kumamoto, reaching about 55,000.



Fukuoka Kenjinkai programs

Exchange Student Scholarships for Descendants of Immigrants from Fukuoka Prefecture

Children of Kenjinkai association members who emigrated from Fukuoka Prefecture are accepted as international students for one year, during which they acquire specialized knowledge and skills at universities or vocational schools in Fukuoka, as well as deepening their understanding of the traditions, culture, industry, economy, etc. of Fukuoka Prefecture. This program has been offered since 1966.

A total of 445 international students have been accepted so far. The returning international students use their knowledge and skills to play an active role in their respective countries, actively participate in Kenjinkai association activities, and contribute to exchange with Fukuoka Prefecture.







Short Term Visit Program for Descendants of Immigrants

Designed to spark children's interest in Fukuoka and deepen their understanding of Fukuoka Prefecture, this program invites the children (elementary school seniors) of Kenjinkai association overseas emigrants to Fukuoka Prefecture for about two weeks. It has been running since 2008.

To date, 231 children have been invited by the program, and through various experiences in Fukuoka, they gain pride in their roots in Fukuoka. After returning to their own countries, they display positive changes such as become more enthusiastic about studying Japanese and participating in taiko drumming groups.

In the future, they are expected to play active roles as the next generation in Kenjinkai activities.









The Overseas Fukuoka Kenjinkai Youth Mission Program

Since 2015, we have been dispatching young people from Fukuoka Prefecture to the overseas Fukuoka Kenjinkai to learn about the history of their ancestors who emigrated overseas, as well as the local social and business situation.

To date, the number of young people sent has reached 45, and by inquiring about the hardships of those who emigrated overseas and their thoughts on Japan and Fukuoka, as well as their interactions with young people overseas, they have gained the mindset for tackling challenges and acquired a more global perspective.

In the future, we expect them to play an active role as a bridge between Fukuoka Prefecture and the Kenjinkai, and between Japan and the countries where the Kenjinkai are located.





【福岡県発】「第10回海外福岡県人会世界大会」が、今月6日から9日にかけて福岡県で開催された。22万国・地域から母県を懐かしむ移住者とその子孫、駐在員ら約350人が集まった。今回ブラジル、ベルー、パラグアイからの参加者を取材し、家族の歴史や母県への思いを聞いた。

大会初日は初冬だったが、上着がなくても寒くない快適な日和となった。記念式典は博多市内のホテルで午後4時半に予定されており、開始30分前になると、各国からの参加者が会場のレゼプションホールに続々と集まってきた。聞こえてくる談笑は日本語のほか、ポルトガル語、スペイン語、英語で交わされている。

世界大会は県人会同士の交流を目的に、1992年にアメリカのロサンゼルスではじまった。以来3年ごとに開催され、福岡での開催は今回で3回目となる。

福岡県の海外移住者数は約5万7千人で、広島、沖縄、離本に次いで4番目に多い。県人会はそれら 移住者とその子孫、駐在具らによって結成され、現在24の国と地域に39団体ある。

式典では小川洋福岡県知事が「みなさんは遠く離れた土地で海外との懸け橋として活躍している」と 接拶し、出席者に敬意を表した。その後、伝統芸能の「豊前神楽」や高校生による合唱が披露され、閉 会後に歓迎レセプションが催された。

ブラジル県人会からは平山イナシオ秀夫会長を始めとする60人が出席。会員の宮崎尾崎ルシア浩美さん(59、二世)は、童謡「ふるさと」を高校生と一緒に合唱し、涙を流していた。

ルシアさんの父・尾崎守さんは農業をしながら、サンパウロ州サンミゲル・アルカンジョ市やイタベ チニンガ市で生涯、日本語教師を務めていた。指導の一環として童謡を教えていて、「ふるさと」はそ のうちの一曲だった。



守さんは娘に礼儀を重んじる教育を徹底していた。ルシアさんは36年前に県費留学し、その際に友人から「日本人より日本人らしい」と呼されたことを今でも誇りに思っている。

守さんは6年前に脳卒中を患い、今年6月に亡くなった。発病してからは会話ができず、ルシア さんは「父がどのような思いで日本的な教育をし ていたのか、元気なうちに聞いておけばよかっ た」と悔やむ。

「福岡は都会になったし外国人が増え、昔とは 違う。それでも父と私にとってはずっと『ふるさ と』。滞在中は父のこと思いながら過ごします』

としんみり話した。今回の訪日を機に留学当時の先生や友人たちと30年ぶりに再会する予定だ。

同じくブラジルから参加した落合良子(りょうこ)さん(88)は3歳で渡伯して以来、初めて日本 に帰ってきた。移住時はまだ効かったため、日本の記憶は全くない。両親や兄弟を既に亡くしていて、 日本に残った観成がどこにいるのかわからなくなってしまった。

37歳のときに夫を亡くして以来、女手一つで息子を育ててきた。いつかは日本に行きたい、と思いながら、仕事と子育てに忙しく機会を失っていた。
