2016-17 Support Program for Promoting Regional Internation

We provide support for activities by private organizations based within Fukuoka Prefecture that aim to progress regional internationalization by promoting grass-roots level international exchange amongst citizens. Application guidelines are outlined below.

Eligible Organizations (must satisfy all of the following)

(1) Activities are based in Fukuoka Prefecture

(2) Not receiving regular assistance from national or local Public Organizations

Non-Profit Organization

Not related to political or religious activities

Not a member of or closely related to criminal organizations

Eligible Projects(held within the prefecture)

(1) Exchange projects or support/consultation for foreign residents (including students)

(2) Projects aiming to develop international understanding amongst youth

(3) International understanding/exchange projects aiming to create a more multicultural society

(4) Other projects contributing to regional internationalization

Details of Support

(1) Provision of venue: the 'Kokusai Hiroba' open space or conference room (2) Financial support: up to half of the relevant expenses, to a maximum of 200,000 yen per project. Relevant expenses are staff, ransportation, accommodation, venue, PR and

printing costs.
(3) PR assistance.

Applications

Ongoing. Generally, applications should be made at least 3 months prior to the project. Please contact us prior to applying. Please bring the application form when meeting with our staff.

**Note: Applications will be closed if the total amount of grants issued reaches the budgeted limit for a given financial year.



Greetings from the Fukuoka International Student Support Center (FiSSC). Together with universities and local governments within the prefecture, FiSSC assists international students by offering consultation, employment support, part time work introduction and promotion of exchange with local residents. In this issue we bring you the final of our 4 instalments of useful information about FiSSC.

Important! Points to keep in mind when hiring international students for part-time jobs

Many international students stay in Japan under the 'student' resident status, which is provided for the purposes of study and, in general, does not allow them to work in the country. As such, they must obtain a "Permission to Engage in Activity other than that Permitted under the Status of Residence" from the local immigration bureau when looking to undertake part time work. With this permission, students are in principle able to work 28 hours per week. In the case of multiple jobs, students must take care to ensure that the total working time per week does not exceed 28 hours.


