Our other activities include, support for Overseas Fukuoka Kenjinkais, promotion of exchange and mutual understanding, and utilization and training of human resources.

# Exchanges between teenagers

(Fukuoka Prefecture, Kingdom of Thailand Bangkok Metropolitan) This year is the 10th year anniversary of the friendship between Fukuoka Prefecture and Bangkok Metropolitan. Among the exchanges in different categories that are still actively being run and improved upon. Every year our foundation receives 20 senior high school students from Bangkok Metropolitan into Fukuoka Prefecture in May and in August Fukuoka Prefecture sends 10 senior high school students to Bangkok Metropolitan in August. This year's program included facility visits such as the factory and museum, in addition to school visits and homestay experience in both of the regions.



Due to the Japanese Government's immigration policy, people of Fukuoka descent and their children organised Overseas Fukuoka Kenjinkais in 9 countries, with 21 regions centred around North America and Latin America. Our foundation is dedicated to support the overseas Fukuoka Kenjinkai, strengthening cooperation with them, training successors for the Kenjinkai, and other various activities. Every 3 years we have The Worldwide Fukuoka Kenjinkai Convention where people from different Fukuoka Kenjinkai around the world gather together, this year the convention took place in Mexico City, Mexico from October 15th-16th.
