The Hawaii-Fukuoka Kenjinkai Opinion Exchange Meeting was held!



On the 22nd April, 2023, an opinion exchange meeting was held in Honolulu, Hawaii, with the Hawaii-Fukuoka Kenjinkai.

The attendees included a visiting group from Fukuoka Prefecture including Governor Hattori and Deputy Chairman Kabashima from the Prefectural Assembly, members of the Hawaii-Fukuoka Kenjinkai including Miles Nomura, and associates from Fukuoka Yukari. Governor Hattori thanked the Kenjinkai members for their activites which continued the connections which had been started by their predecessors. At the meeting, the attendees discussed how to take back the time taken away by the COVID-19 pandemic, and had a friendly back and forth for as long as time allowed.

The Short Term Visit Program was held!

The Short Term Visit Program for Descendants of Immigrants from Fukuoka Prefecture is held every year, inviting children and adult leaders who have roots in Fukuoka Prefecture, from the Kenjinkais of 20 countries. This year, the Short Term Visit Program was held between the 7th to the 18th July, with 10 children and 6 adult leaders coming to visit Fukuoka Prefecture. The goal of the program is for the participants to understand their ancestral home of Fukuoka Prefecture, with the hope that they too will grow into leadership roles in their own Kenjinkais, continuing the mutual relationship between their country and Fukuoka as well as wider Japan.

This time, the participants visited an elementary school, and the children could mingle with children their own age. They not only experienced the prefecture's nature and history, but also had a chance to study programming. Studying and experiencing Fukuoka Prefecture first-hand, the participants deepened their understanding of their ancestral home.
